Committee member Walsh reported the O.C.S.D. Homeless Liaison Officers have been moved into the new bureau. CalTrans has placed the scheduled abatement of the homeless encampment at Cristianitos on hold for several weeks. Additionally, City Council has voted to disband the Joint Homeless Subcommittee effective 8/31/2021.

Committee member Loeffler expressed disappointment in the removal of the public safety aspect from any homeless committee. He praised the efforts and hard work of Karlie Hunter since coming to the City of San Clemente.

Capt. Benfield reported the program for body worn cameras is scheduled to go to the Board of Supervisors today for approval. O.C.S.D. is working on evacuation maps, to include a QR code, for the public for wildland fire areas in San Clemente. O.C.S.D. is seeing a large rise in Fentanyl deaths and Fentanyl seizures in Orange County.

Chair Berkuta announced the oral interviews and selections for the Public Safety Committee will take place at tonight's City Council meeting.

Committee Member Loeffler announced the current Public Safety Committee has an additional meeting before new appointees taking their position on August 31, 2021. He also stated the new fire truck is now operational at Station 59.

City staff announced the Flock Camera was proposed to City Council, included in the Fiscal Year 2021-22 budget, and was accepted for the 15-camera option at \$42,500.00 initial investment. Additional information will become available when the process to solicit bids begins. Mr. Atamian announced Karlie Hunter San Clemente's new Community Outreach Worker.
