CITY ANNOUNCES AVAILABILITY OF DRAFT SAN CLEMENTE COASTAL RESILIENCY PLAN

October 7, 2021...San Clemente, California...The City announces that a Draft Coastal Resiliency Plan is available for a six-week public comment period beginning October 7, 2021 through November 18, 2021. The Draft Coastal Resiliency Plan is posted on the City's website homepage at this [link](#).

The Coastal Resiliency Plan serves as a long-range planning and guidance document to address future potential sea-level rise and its effects in the City. The Coastal Resiliency Plan builds on the findings and recommendations contained in the City's [2019 Sea Level Rise Vulnerability Assessment](#) and recommends a phased approach to improving long-term coastal resiliency for existing structures including critical public infrastructure.

The Coastal Resiliency Plan will be presented to the City's Beaches, Parks and Recreation Commission at 6:00 pm on October 12, 2021, the City's Planning Commission at 7:00 pm on November 3, 2021, and the City Council in December 2021.

The Coastal Resiliency Plan is one of the last deliverables of a Local Coastal Program Planning Grant awarded to the City in 2017.
