Subject: 2021 SITE SPECIFIC PARK MASTER PLAN UPDATES – SECOND DRAFT CONCEPTUAL

**DESIGNS** 

Staff recommends that the Commission provide comments on the second draft of the Summary:

> site-specific park master plan conceptual designs. The purpose of this review is to allow the Commission and the public to provide additional comments on the designs

before final drafts are presented to the City Council for approval.

Background: At its March 2, 2021 meeting, the City Council awarded a contract to SWA, a

landscape architect firm, to update five site-specific park master plans for Bonito Canyon Park, Linda Lane Park, Richard T. Steed Memorial Park, San Gorgonio Park,

and San Luis Rey Park.

Per the agreement, SWA and the Beaches, Parks and Recreation Department compiled and released a survey to the public in April 2021 to gather feedback and comments on the five parks listed above. Following the survey, public workshops were held on May 11, 2021, and May 13, 2021, that offered community members an opportunity to provide comments directly to SWA and City staff regarding park amenities.

At its September 2, 2021 meeting, the Beaches, Parks and Recreation Commission provided comments on the first draft conceptual designs of the site-specific park master plans.

On September 22, 2021, and September 23, 2021, on-site park open houses were held to gather feedback and answer questions regarding the first draft conceptual designs. On October 21, 2021, a public forum was held at the Community Center as an additional opportunity for the public to comment and ask questions regarding the first draft conceptual designs.

Discussion:

After a considerable amount of public feedback and comments, the first draft conceptual designs have been modified and the second draft conceptual plans have been provided by SWA (Attachment 1). All public comments received are on file with the Beaches, Parks and Recreation Department and available for inspection upon request.

The following information provides a greater understanding of each park's intended use as designated through the 1999 and 2018 Beaches, Parks & Recreation Master Agenda Report Page 2

Plans. The park designation definitions provided below are taken into consideration when drafting the site plan updates.

<u>Neighborhood Parks</u>: Neighborhood parks are designed to serve the needs of local neighborhoods. They are generally less than 10 acres in size. Typical facilities in these parks include children's play areas, picnic areas, restroom buildings, sports courts, exercise areas, and open turf.

<u>Community Parks</u>: Community parks are designed to serve larger portions of the City or the entire City. They are generally over 10 acres in size. These parks include major sports facilities such as baseball, softball, soccer, football, tennis, and basketball. These facilities generally include field lighting and parking lots to accommodate high use. Neighborhood park amenities (picnic areas and children's play areas) are also included since community parks are also designed to serve neighborhood park needs.

Staff and SWA are seeking comments from the Commission on the second draft of conceptual plan and a final recommendation to provide to the City Council regarding the second draft designs. Once final recommendations are received by the Commission, SWA will prepare construction cost estimates per the Professional Services Agreement to be presented to the City Council for its consideration.

STAFF RECOMMENDS THAT the Beaches, Parks & Recreation Commission provide comment and a recommendation to the City Council regarding the second draft of conceptual designs for site-specific park master plans for Bonito Canyon Park, Linda Lane Park, Richard T. Steed Memorial Park, San Gorgonio Park, and San Luis Rey Park.











# San Gorgonio concept illustrative plan




