Funding is now in place to execute a plan but we have yet be able to get this project off the ground. The good news is that we now have funding, but Staff must keep this in front of our Council. We need to meet with a representative from the Army Corp of Engineers/a rep from Mike Levin's office, and our Sand Replenishment Sub Committee. In this meeting I would hope to hear a plan or our sub committee propose a plan, and ensure everyone is on the same page with some realistic target dates.

The entire Park Master Plan appears to be stagnant in the eyes of our residents, and as a BPRCA member we have received no updates to provide residents that inquiry in passing. Pickleball at San G., always a hot topic. We just need to update our community where we stand, even if it means these projects have been placed on hold.
