City Announces Public Meetings on the Nature Based Coastal Resiliency Project

February 6, 2023... San Clemente, California.... The City is preparing a Nature Based Coastal Resiliency Project Feasibility Study that identifies critical beach erosion hot spots and solutions to address short-term and long-term coastal erosion. The first public outreach meeting will be held at 6:00 pm on Tuesday, February 14, 2023 by the City's Beaches, Parks and Recreation Commission at the San Clemente City Council Chambers. The purpose of the City's Nature Based Coastal Resiliency Project Feasibility Study is to identify feasible solutions to promote long-term resiliency of the City's beaches by retaining sand and reducing sand loss. The goal of the Study is to identify pilot projects for implementation and public input is essential to this Study. Residents and other interested parties are encouraged to attend to provide input on preferred coastal resiliency solutions. The Nature Based Coastal Resiliency Project Feasibility Study implements key recommendations in the Coastal Resiliency Plan (2021) and Sea Level Rise Vulnerability Assessment (2019).
