ACCEPTANCE AND NOTICE OF COMPLETION FOR THE CITYWIDE CATCH BASINS REHABILITATION. CIP PROJECT NO. 21001

Fiscal Impact:

The construction cost of \$169,350 is within the approved construction budget of \$178,600 from the Storm Drain Depreciation Reserve Fund.

Summary:

Acceptance and Notice of Completion for Cheloletty Engineering for contract work of the Citywide Catch Basins Rehabilitation, located throughout the City. Refer to Attachment 1 for Location Map and Attachment 2 for Notice of Completion.

Background:

On September 20, 2022, City Council awarded a construction contract to Cheloletty Engineering to rehabilitate various catch basins to improve their useful life and prevent flooding (Attachment 3). The project consisted of repairing the existing catch basins decks, sidewalks, curb and gutter within the catch basin repair areas.

A summary of construction expenditures is provided below:

Construction Management and Inspection \$ 5,750
Construction \$163,600
Total Project Construction cost \$169,350

Recommended Actions:

Staff Recommends that the City Council:

- 1. Accept the Citywide Catch Basins Rehabilitation, CIP Project No. 21001, from Cheloletty Engineering.
- Authorize the Public Works Director/City Engineer to execute and record the Notice of Completion for the Citywide Catch Basins Rehabilitation, CIP Project No. 21001.
- 3. Authorize the City Clerk to release the Payment Bond 35 days from the recordation of the Notice of Completion upon verification with the Engineering Division that no liens have been levied against the Contractor, Cheloletty Engineering.



CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT AWARD TO CHELOLETTY ENGINEERING FOR THE CITYWIDE CATCH BASINS REHABILITATION, CIP PROJECT NO. 21001

Fiscal Impact:

Yes. The estimated total construction cost of \$178,000 is within the available approved project budget of \$180,000 from the Storm Drain Depreciation Reserve fund, CIP Project No. 21001.

Summary:

Staff recommends approval of a construction contract with Cheloletty Engineering, in the amount of \$148,600 (i.e. base bid and selected alternate items), for the Citywide Catch Basin Rehabilitation.

Background:

Catch basins are vital components of the storm drain systems throughout the City. Some of these catch basins are in need of repair to improve their useful life and prevent flooding. The proposed project will replace and reconstruct existing catch basins decks, sidewalks, curb and gutter within the catch basin repair areas at various locations in the City of San Clemente.

On July 19, 2022, City Council rejected all bids and directed staff to revise the bid package and re-bid the project (Attachment 2). A new bid package for the Citywide Catch Basin Rehabilitation project was re-advertised for competitive bidding on the PlanetBids website. The new bid package included alternative bid items that could be added to the base bid, at the City's discretion, at the time of contract award. Four bids were received on August 23, 2022, ranging from \$123,000 to \$198,900 (i.e. base bid), as shown on Attachment 3. The lowest responsive bidder was Cheloletty Engineering of Villa Park, California, at \$123,000.

Based on the low base bid and selected alternate bid items, the construction cost is estimated as follows:

Construction Management, Administration \$15,000
Construction Contract 148,600
Contingency (10%) 15,000

Total Estimated Construction Costs \$178,600

As required by City Policy and State Law, the Contractor will be required to provide performance and payment bonds simultaneously with execution of the construction contract (Attachment 4). Project plans and specifications are on file in the City Clerk's Office.
