Our second week of Junior Guards has been a blast! With the 4th of July holiday on Tuesday, there was plenty of excitement among our Junior Guards to last the whole week.

The JG I, JG II and LCC classes started off the week with pier jumps, while the Ripper classes took part in sand castle building contests and body boarding.



When the JG's weren't catching waves on their surfboards or the 9-person SUPsquatch, they had fun playing sand soccer, volleyball, nation ball, capture the flag, and competing in rescue relays.

JG instructors covered many important topics with their classes this week:

- First Aid: lacerations and bleeding
- How to treat a C-Spine injury
- Oceanography: tides and marine life
- CPR
- Responding from the tower to prevents, rescues, and ordinances
- Tower 0 operations

On Friday, the Cal State Long Beach Shark Lab will visit our JG's and discuss shark behavior and how scientists track them.


About Us
