### Significant Change:

The Police budget increases to \$21.3 million, with the OCSD contract total of \$18.5 million funded in the General Fund Other Contractual services costs include crossing guards, citation processing and legal costs for enforcement. Interdepartmental charges increase by \$52,490 due to fleet cost increases.

Debt amounts represent the CalPERS Safety plan pension liability payment for past police personnel. Capital costs include the addition of a motorcycle budgeted at \$31,890.
