City Announces Extension of Public Comment Period on Coastal Resiliency Concepts

October 31, 2023... San Clemente, California.... The City has extended the timeline for receiving comments on the draft conceptual coastal resiliency designs by two additional weeks to provide the public with additional opportunities to submit comments to the City. The coastal resiliency design concepts are a key element of the City's *Nature Based Coastal Resiliency Project Feasibility Study* which seeks to identify solutions to erosion in the City, building on the upcoming City's USACE public beach restoration project. The design concepts are on the City's LCP webpage for an additional two weeks through November 17, 2023 for public comment.

Community input is an essential component of the study and residents and other stakeholders are encouraged to provide input on the preliminary design concepts presented to the public at a community meeting on September 27, 2023.
