Design Guidelines - Review of Draft Document Dated July 1991

<u>Senior Planner O'Hara</u> reviewed the purpose of the Design Guidelines and the review/adoption process; advised that comments concerning the draft document can either be submitted to her in writing or expressed orally at the Public Hearings. The Design Guidelines draft, dated July 1991, is on file in the City Clerk's Department.

Wes Landen, Chairperson of the Urban Design Advisory Committee, summarized the efforts of the Committee in developing the Design Guidelines; reviewed the Committee's composition, focusing on the diversity of the members; noted the Design Guidelines represent a consensus of the Committee.

Gerald Gast, Gast, Hillmer & Associates, noted the City does not currently have clear guidelines to apprise developers of desired design features; reviewed the general principles of the Design Guidelines, focusing on site planning, architecture, scale and landscaping; explained the document only references signage insofar as encouraging that signage design be integrated with the architecture of the structure; recommended that signage be addressed by a special task force, with participation by the Chamber of Commerce and business community; stressed the need for a strong consensus among decision makers to ensure that the Design Guidelines are useful; reviewed slides and illustrations which demonstrated desired and undesirable design elements; stressed the importance of pedestrian-oriented projects.

In answer to Council inquiry, Staff advised that actual photographs can be included in the Design Guidelines if desired, although the cost of producing the document will increase; noted that an archive of desirable projects is available.

<u>Phil DeProtine</u> spoke in support of including actual photographs in the Design Guidelines, as opposed to illustrations; urged that palm trees be de-emphasized, especially in parking lots; spoke in support of addressing creative night lighting and signage in the document.

<u>David Light</u>, Architect, 208 Princesa, voiced concern that developers have been required to adhere to Spanish architecture in non-historic districts.

<u>Jill West</u> questioned who would conduct discretionary design review; commented that knowledgeable and qualified people should undertake this function.

Gary Wiggle opined the Design Guidelines is an excellent document, but is not strict enough; voiced concern that the document is too discretionary; opined the issue of stucco should be addressed in detail; suggested that the following paragraph, which is currently contained on Page 63 of the Design Guidelines, should be moved to the beginning of the document: "Excessive use of architectural elements or ornament can detract from the overall appearance of a building. The beauty of San Clemente's original architecture can be attributed to the satisfying proportions and scale of the buildings, plantings and spaces around them." Mr. Wiggle further commented that the Design Guidelines should be modified to include more "Do's" and "Don'ts" and opined that in some cases the words "should" and "shall" are inappropriately reversed; opined that incentives should be established to encourage developers to provide amenities, such as setbacks, courtyards, etc.; opined that service stations should be specifically addressed.

<u>Frank Montesinos</u> voiced concern that the document does not address balance and symmetry; spoke in support of buildings that are elegant in design and do not include excessive ornamentation; spoke in support of including theme towers on projects; voiced concern that discretionary review lends itself to numerous interpretations.

<u>Jamie Lewis</u> spoke in support of the Design Guidelines; concurred with the existence of a discretionary review board; volunteered time and film to provide visuals to aid developers.

Kathy Brocklehurst, 304 Avenida Monterey, relayed that security in design should be considered.

<u>Marilyn Coduti</u> spoke in support of a Cultural Heritage Board to protect historic structures; suggested that a strict requirement should be imposed to mandate that historic structures that are demolished be replaced with a structure that is consistent with the architecture of the original Spanish structure.

Mayor Diehl reviewed the tentative Public Hearing schedule for the Design Guidelines as follows:

September 10, 1991 - Community Design Commission Public Hearing October 1, 1991 - Planning Commission Public Hearing October 23, 1991 - City Council Public Hearing.
