PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AND INVOCATION

DECLARATION OF ELECTION RESULTS

In accordance with Resolution No. 30-84, the canvass of the returns of the election held April 10, 1984, was made on April 17, 1984, and the Clerk then read the results and presented his "Certificate of Canvass".

Upon motion of Councilman Carr, seconded by Councilman Limberg, and unanimously carried, RESOLUTION NO. 30-84, BEING A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN CLEMENTE, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN SAID CITY OF SAN CLEMENTE ON THE 10TH DAY OF APRIL, 1984, DECLARING THE RESULT THEREOF AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW was regularly introduced, passed, and adopted.

RESOLUTION NO. 30-84

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN CLEMENTE, CALIFORNIA RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN SAID CITY OF SAN CLEMENTE ON THE 10TH DAY OF APRIL, 1984, DECLARING THE RESULT THEREOF AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS ARE PROVIDED BY LAW

WHEREAS, a regular general municipal election was held and conducted in the City of San Clemente, County of Orange, State of California, on Tuesday, the 10th day of April, 1984, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of said election was duly and regularly given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects said election was held and conducted and the votes cast thereat, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 8-84, adopted the 4th day of January, 1984, the City Clerk of the City of San Clemente canvassed the returns of said election and has certified the results to this City Council, said results are received, attached and made a part thereof as "Exhibit A."

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN CLEMENTE, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That there were 17 voting precincts established for the purpose of holding said election consisting of consolidations of the regular election precincts in the City of San Clemente as established for the holding of state and county elections.

SECTION 2. The said regular general municipal election was held for the purpose of electing the following officers of said City as required by the laws relating to cities in the State of California, to wit:

Two members of the City Council of said City for the full term of four years;

A City Clerk of said City for the full term of four years;

A City Treasurer of said City for the full term of four years.

SECTION 3. That at said regular general municipal election, the following initiative measure was submitted to the electors of said City, to wit:

PROPOSITION A

Shall the Ordinance be adopted which (a) prohibits closing down the existing wastewater treatment facility located at Avenida Pico in the City of San Clemente, (b) prohibits shifting such services to any other wastewater treatment facilities, (c) requires that all future needs for such services be met by expansion of the existing wastewater treatment facility, and (d) that said ordinance shall be amended or repealed only by the voters?

SECTION 4. That the whole number of votes cast in said City (except absent voter ballots) was 4898.

That the whole number of absent voter ballots cast in said City was 207, making a total of 5105 votes cast in said City.

SECTION 6. The City Council does declare and determine that;

ROBERT D. "BOB" LIMBERG was elected as Member of the City Council of said City for the full term of four years;

BILL MECHAM was elected as Member of the City Council of said City for the full term of four years;

MAX L. BERG was elected City Clerk of said City for the full term of four years;

ROBERT F. "BOB" MORRIS was elected City Treasurer of said City for the full term of four years.

That as a result of said election, a majority of the qualified voters voting on said measure relating to the wastewater treatment facility located at Avenida Pico in the City of San Clemente voted in favor thereof, and that said proposition was carried, and shall be deemed adopted and ratified.

SECTION 7. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of said City a statement of the result of said election, showing:

- (1) The whole number of votes cast in the city;
- (2) The names of the persons voted for;
- (3) The measure voted upon;
- (4) For what office each person was voted for;
- (5) The number of votes given at each precinct to each person, and for and against each measure;
- (6) The number of votes given in the City to each person, and for and against each measure.

SECTION 8. That the City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of such persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and duly authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the State Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe thereto and file the same in the office of the City Clerk. Whereupon, each and all of said persons so elected shall be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

SECTION 9. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution; shall enter the same in the book of original Resolutions of said City; and shall make a minute of passage and adoption thereof in the records of the proceedings of the City Council of said City, in the minutes of the meeting at which the same is passed and adopted.

OATH OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Diehl administered the Oath of Allegiance to the City Clerk and presented him with his certificate of election.

Mayor Diehl then turned the gavel over to the City Clerk who administered the Oath of Allegiance in unison to Councilman-elect Robert D. Limberg, Councilman-elect William C. Mecham, and City-Treasurer-elect Robert F. Morris. The Clerk then presented them with their "Certificate of Election" and offered congratulations.

The newly elected Council members were seated and the Mayor congratulated Council members Limberg and Mecham and both stated they were very appreciative of the support given them by the community and were looking forward to four more years on the Council.

Mayor Diehl then thanked his wife and children for their support in the past year and thanked God for a successful year. He pointed to a number of Council accomplishments during his "Yes We Can" year, including running the "best run and supported animal shelter in California"; pier reconstruction; the Nixon Library; starting work on the Estrella Golf Course; adding a second police dog to the force; neighborhood watch program reducing crime; establishment of a policy designed to rebuild and cut down costs in street reconstruction; and City assistance in obtaining approval of new Seniors housing complex.

ROLL CALL OF NEWLY CONSTITUTED COUNCIL

The Mayor turned the gavel over to the City Clerk who took the chair and called the roll of the newly constituted Council.

SELECTION OF MAYOR

The City Clerk then advised that this was the time and place for the selection of a Mayor for the coming year and called for nominations. Councilwoman Koester nominated Councilman Carr. There being no further nominations the Clerk declared the nominations closed, AND IT WAS MOVED BY MAYOR DIEHL, SECONDED BY COUNCILWOMAN KOESTER, AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED that the City Clerk be instructed to cast the unanimous ballot of the Council for Councilman Carr as Mayor of the City of San Clemente.

The Clerk then declared Councilman Carr elected Mayor and passed him the gavel offering congratulations.

SELECTION OF MAYOR PRO TEMPORE

Mayor Carr assumed the chair, and then called for nominations for Mayor Pro Tempore, and Councilman Limberg nominated Councilman Mecham. There being no further nominations the Mayor declared the nominations closed, AND IT WAS MOVED BY COUNCILMAN DIEHL, SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN LIMBERG, AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED that the unanimous ballot of the Council be cast for Councilman Mecham as Mayor pro tempore.

REMARKS FROM COUNCIL MEMBERS

Councilman Mecham then thanked Councilman Diehl for a job very well done this past year noting there were a few difficult meetings; and commended him for his theme of "Yes We Can", and that he was proud to serve with him on the Council. Mayor Carr seconded Councilman Mecham's thoughts noting that Councilman Diehl has done a very creditable job serving as Mayor, and that he will be a hard person to follow. Mayor Carr then presented a plaque to Councilman Diehl for his service to the citizens and successful term as Mayor.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, IT WAS MOVED BY COUNCILMAN LIMBERG, SECONDED BY COUNCILWOMAN KOESTER, AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED that the meeting be adjourned at 7:30 P.M. in memory of William A. Mecham, recently deceased father of Councilman Mecham.
