SPECIAL BUSINESS

Subject: 67 - Urgency Ordinance No. 790 Amending Municipal Code Section 2-8(c).

IN RE: Proposed amendment to Section 2-8(c) of the Municipal Code relating to the term of office of appointed members of the City Council.

The City Attorney noted that existing Municipal Code Section 2-8(c) would require that appointed Council members Lane and O'Keefe would have to step down from the Council on the day of the Special Election, November 4, 1980; that since it may be a few weeks after the election before the Registrar of Voters is able to certify the results no one could take office until such results are certified; and if either or both Council members Lane and O'Keefe were re-elected they could not remain on the Council between the date of election and the date when certification has been made and the Clerk could administer the oath of office.

The Council concurred that the section should be amended to provide that members remain on the Council until they or their successor is duly elected and administered the oath of office.

Upon motion of Councilman O'Keefe, seconded by Councilman Limberg, and unanimously carried, ORDINANCE NO. 790, BEING AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN CLEMENTE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 2-8(c) OF THE CODF OF THE CITY OF SAN CLEMENTE RELATING TO THE TERM OF OFFICE OF APPOINTED MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL, was regularly introduced by title only, the reading in full thereof unanimously waived, and duly passed as an urgency Ordinance.
