

Helpful Information for Slope Properties

Construction Information from Metrolink and OCTA

Metrolink, in coordination with the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), is constructing a temporary catchment wall adjacent to the San Clemente Beach Trail at Mariposa Point. The wall will be constructed with steel beams encased in concrete and large wood planks installed between the beams. Drill rigs as well as additional equipment and materials have been brought into the work area using the North Beach parking lot and the trail. The trail is closed from the beach parking lot to the work area.

Construction of the wall began Tuesday, February 27, and will continue for approximately one month. Work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. daily, including weekends. This work may be loud. The schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather or unforeseen operational issues. Train horns may be sounded during this time.
