My name is Heather Dowell and I am a current resident of the [REDACTED]. I am writing today in support of KEEPING the existing traffic delineators at the intersection of El Camino and Esplanade. Prior to the installation, there were multiple accidents every year at the top of our street. Since the delineators were installed there have been ZERO accidents at this intersection. Without question, the data shows that the traffic delineators have greatly increased the safety of this intersection.

In addition, should the delineators be removed and the alternative plan of creating traffic pockets be adopted and no parking zones created, I have great concern for the loss of parking for the restaurants at the top of our street. Customers of Lucky Dog Gelato and the soon to open Buona Forchetta will lose vital parking places which will likely negatively affect their business.

As I understand, keeping the existing delineators is ZERO cost to the city. I hope maintaining the safety of the intersection, keeping existing parking for the best interest of local business, and fiscal responsibility are all priorities of our city council members. Please KEEP the traffic delineators at the El Camino/Esplanade intersection.
