After many accidents at the intersection, the delineators currently installed reduced that number to zero, greatly increasing safety! Not only prohibiting the left turn onto northbound El Camino Real from east bound Esplanade, but the left turn from northbound El Camino Real onto westbound Esplanade. The current scenario is by far the safest (K-rail would be even better), the delineators greatly reduce the flow of traffic down our street. By removing those and installing left hand turn lanes, you will turn Esplanade into a freeway to the beach!
