## San Clemente Shoreline Sand Replenishment Project

The sand replenishment project started on December 21, 2023 and was paused on January 9, 2024 due to sediment quality issues. At its March 19, 2024 meeting, the City Council unanimously approved a modification to the project to support the use of an alternate "borrow site" (source of sand). With this modification, the US Army Corps of Engineers will direct the contractor to return to San Clemente in mid to late April to complete the beach sand project following completion of beach sand projects in Solana Beach & Encinitas in San Diego County. <u>www.san-clemente.org/beachsand</u>

# **OCTA Coastal Rail Resiliency Study**
