a right-thinking man - fair-minded, considerate and at all times a gentleman. Mr. McKinney further remarked that he felt Mr. Campbell had done everything he could during his term of office to further the interests of the City, and he concluded by thanking Mr. Campbell for the association which he had greatly enjoyed, and wishing him continued success in San Clemente.
