Status updates on items of interest in San Clemente!



San Clemente Shoreline Sand Replenishment Project

The sand replenishment project is well underway! Sand placement will occur seven days a week through late May. At the current pace, approximately half of the total sand quantity in this placement cycle will be delivered this spring, with the project resuming in the fall of 2024 to place the remaining quantity of sand. A combined total of 251,000 cubic yards of sand is scheduled to be placed between Linda Lane and T-Street beaches. www.san-clemente.org/beachsand

Mariposa Point Pedestrian Bridge (Beach Trail)

The pedestrian bridge at Mariposa Point on the San Clemente Beach Trail remains closed after significant slope movement required bridge sections to be removed. Orange County Transportation Authority has performed emergency work in the area to restore train service through San Clemente. While the slope movement in the Mariposa Point area is still active, there are current efforts for the future restoration of this important Beach Trail connection, including:

- Existing bridge structures are being evaluated to determine if repair or replacement is needed.
- Alternative solutions for the Beach Trail connection are being explored.
- Funding for future improvements is being identified. www.san-clemente.org/projects
