Community Meeting on Coastal Resiliency Concepts Scheduled July 18

July 16, 2024... San Clemente, California.... The City's Coastal Advisory Committee has scheduled a presentation to update the community on the third round of sand retention concepts proposed to complement the City's comprehensive sand replenishment strategy.

The community meeting will be held Thursday, July 18, 2024 at 4pm in the Council Chambers at San Clemente City Hall and will provide the public with an opportunity to review the updated sand retention design concepts and to provide input and feedback to the City.

Community input is an essential part of this effort and residents and other stakeholders are encouraged to provide input on preferred shoreline solutions either in person by attending the meeting on July 18 or online after the meeting. The design concepts for sand retention are central to the City's *Nature Based Resiliency Project Feasibility Study* which seeks to identify solutions to erosion, building on the City's comprehensive sand replenishment strategy.
