INTRODUCTION (FIRST READING) OF AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CITYWIDE POSTED SPEED LIMITS AND FINDING THE ORDINANCE CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT

Fiscal Impact:

None.

Summary:

The City Council is being asked to consider Ordinance No. 1780 (Attachment 1), that would establish speed limits based on the Engineering and Traffic Survey (E&TS) summarized on the attached Speed Summary (Attachment 2) with no changes to current speed limits.

Reevaluating all non-statutory speed limits every five years is necessary to comply with the California Vehicle Code (CVC) and the California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (CA MUTCD) when changes to roads have been made. Although the E&TS study shows that some posted speed limits could be increased (*i.e.*, Avenida Vaquero, Avenida Salvador, and Calle Frontera, etc.), the E&TS and Assembly Bill No. 43 (as amended) allow the City to keep the existing posted speed limits without any changes based on certain findings. Staff analysis determined that no streets would qualify to reduce their posted speed limit. Accordingly, the recommendation is to adopt speed limits with no changes from the existing codified posted limits.

Background:

The CVC and CA MUTCD govern the criteria for establishment of speed limits in local municipalities. For speed limits to be valid and enforceable, CVC Sections 22348-22358 and 40802 require that an E&TS be conducted every five years in order to justify posted speed limits for non-statutory streets.

CVC Section 40802 allows an E&TS to remain valid for seven or fourteen years in certain cases related to citing officer radar/lidar certification, timely radar calibration, and an engineering determination that underlying roadway or traffic conditions have remained unchanged. Since there have been some changes implemented on the City's transportation infrastructure within the last five years, a new E&TS was conducted in order to certify speed limits on a citywide basis.

CVC Section 22358.6 requires agencies to establish speed limits at or near the surveyed 85th percentile speed. The 85th percentile speed is defined as the speed at which 85% of vehicles

documented in the E&TS travel at or below. Typically, the 85th percentile speed is rounded to the nearest five (5) mile per hour (mph) increment to establish the speed limit. CVC Section 22358.6 also allows an agency to round the surveyed 85th percentile speed down to the lower 5 mph increment to establish the speed limit even when mathematical rounding would otherwise require rounding up to the nearest 5 mph. However, in these instances, an additional 5 mph reduction is not permitted beyond the rounding down.

For example, a speed survey that is rounded to the nearest 5 mph increment or that lands on an even 5 mph increment may be reduced an additional 5 mph to establish the speed limit when conditions and justification are documented in the E&TS and approved by a registered Civil and/or Traffic Engineer.

If the City Council finds that the speed limit is still more than is reasonable or safe after completing an E&TS, the City has the authority by ordinance to retain the current speed limit or restore the immediately prior one if the previous speed limit was established by an E&TS and if a registered engineer has evaluated that section of the highway and determined that no additional general purpose lanes have been added to the roadway since completion of the traffic survey that established that speed limit. These requirements are set forth in CVC Section 22358.8.

Staff has conducted speed surveys for City streets that require a current E&TS to justify posted speed limits. Attachment 2 summarizes the speed survey results and the recommended speed for each roadway. Based on these findings, retaining the existing speed limits and making no changes to posted speed limits is advised.

Maintaining current posted speed limits was unanimously recommended for approval by the Planning Commission at their meeting on June 26, 2024.

Council Options:

- Introduce and conduct the first reading of Ordinance No. 1780, making findings and establishing posted speed limits on City streets and determining the action is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
- Revise, introduce and conduct the first reading of Ordinance No. 1780.
- Continue the item and direct staff to provide additional information.
- Do not introduce Ordinance No. 1780 and deny the establishment of posted speed limits on City streets. Note: this action would result in citation of certain speed infractions as legally unenforceable.

Environmental Review/Analysis:

The Planning Commission and staff are recommending that the City Council determine this action to be categorically exempt from CEQA under Class 1 (Existing Facilities, 14 CCR section 15301(c)), and Class 21 (Enforcement Actions by Regulatory Agencies, 14 CCR section 15321) of the State CEQA Guidelines.

Recommended Actions:

Planning Commission and City staff recommend that the City Council introduce and conduct a first reading of Ordinance No. 1780 entitled: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN CLEMENTE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SAN CLEMENTE MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 10 – VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, CHAPTER 10.16 TO ESTABLISH CITYWIDE POSTED SPEED LIMITS AND FINDING THE ACTION CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT, which would maintain all current speed limits.

ORDINANCE NO. 1780

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN CLEMENTE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SAN CLEMENTE MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 10 – VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, CHAPTER 10.16 TO ESTABLISH CITYWIDE POSTED SPEED LIMITS AND FINDING THE ACTION CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT

WHEREAS, the City of San Clemente, California ("City") is a municipal corporation, duly organized under the constitution and laws of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, existing municipal code provisions under San Clemente Municipal Code (SCMC) Chapter 10.16 regulate the posted speed limits within the City, and

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code (CVC) Sections 22348-22358 and 40802 provide that state and local agencies should conduct engineering studies at least once every 5, 7 or 14 years to reevaluate non-statutory speed limits on segments of their roadways that have undergone significant changes since the last review, such as the addition or elimination of parking or driveways, changes in the number of travel lanes, changes in the configuration of bicycle lanes, changes in traffic control signal coordination, or significant changes in traffic volumes; and

WHEREAS, the City has conducted the required speed surveys and engineering studies upon existing and new streets in the City; and

WHEREAS, CVC Section 22358.6 provides that when a speed limit is to be posted, it shall be established at the nearest 5 mph increment of the 85th-percentile speed of free-flowing traffic, except as shown in the two Options below for rounding down and using 5 mph speed reduction, or rounding up, or if using additional 5 mph speed reduction on local agency roadways for safety corridor designation (CVC Section 22358.7(a)(1)) or adjacent to land or facility generating high concentrations of bicyclists and pedestrians (CVC Section 22358.7(a)(2)). If the speed limit to be posted has had the 5 mph reduction applied, then an E&TS shall document in writing the conditions and justification for the lower speed limit and be approved by a registered Civil or Traffic Engineer. The reasons for the lower speed limit shall be in compliance with CVC Sections 627 and 22358.5; and

WHEREAS, CVC Section 22358.8(a) provides that a city may, by ordinance, retain the current speed limit or restore the immediately prior speed limit if, after the completion of an engineering and traffic study, the local authority finds that the speed limit is still more than is reasonable or safe, if that speed limit was established with an engineering and traffic survey and if a registered engineer has evaluated the section of highway and determined that no additional general purpose lanes have been added to the roadway since completion of the traffic survey that established the prior speed limit; and

WHEREAS, the City's Traffic Engineer has reviewed the street segments and has identified justifiable zoning, street configurations, and safety considerations and recommends that the necessary determinations to be made in order to uphold the current speed limits while also ensuring compliance with all relevant CVC codes; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission at their regular meeting of June 26, 2024 made a recommendation to the City Council to approve the establishment of speed limits based on the recent Engineering and Traffic Survey that would maintain current speed limits, and determine the project as categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act under Class 1 (Existing Facilities, 14 CCR section 15301(c)), and Class 21 (Enforcement Actions by Regulatory Agencies, 14 CCR section 15321) of the State CEQA Guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of San Clemente, California, hereby ordains as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: Incorporation of Recitals. The recitals above are true and correct and are hereby incorporated as findings as if fully set forth herein.

<u>Section 2</u>: **CEQA**. Based on the entire record as a whole, the City Council finds and determines that this Ordinance is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Class 1 (Existing Facilities, 14 CCR section 15301(c)), and Class 21 (Enforcement Actions by Regulatory Agencies, 14 CCR section 15321) of the State CEQA Guidelines because it maintains existing speed limits, allows existing speed limits to be enforced and has no possibility of making a direct or foreseeably indirect substantial impact on the environment.

<u>Section 3</u>: Under California Vehicle Code 22358.8 and based on the evaluation of the Engineering and Traffic Survey and street configuration by the City's Traffic Engineer, the City Council finds and determines that the current speed limits for the following streets were established with an engineering and traffic survey, that a registered engineer has evaluated the section of highway and determined that no additional general purpose lanes have been added to the roadway since completion of the traffic survey that established that speed limit, that the posted speed limits on the following streets are still more than is reasonable or safe, and that the currently adopted speed limits on the following street shall be retained based on the following justifications:

<u>Section 8</u>: **Publication.** The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance by the City Council and cause it, or a summary of it, to be published once within 15 days of adoption in a newspaper of general circulation printed and published within the City of San Clemente, and shall post a certified copy of this ordinance, including the vote for and against the same, in the Office of the City Clerk in accordance with California Government Code Section 36933.

<u>Section 9</u>: Records. The documents and materials associated with this ordinance that constitute the record of proceedings on which the City Council's findings and determinations are based are located at City Hall, 910 Calle Negocio, San Clemente, CA 92673.

<u>Section 10</u>: Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity has no effect on the other provisions or applications of the ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this extent, the provisions of this ordinance are severable. The City Council declares that it would have adopted this ordinance irrespective of the invalidity of any portion thereof.

<u>Section 11</u>: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective 30 days after its adoption.

Section 12: The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and cause
