COMMITTEE NAME: HUMAN AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

Project Name: SAFE Fee Supplement for Underprivileged School Volunteers

Purpose, Goals and Deliverables of Project: Investigate the city paying for a strawman pilot program to pay for LIFESCAN fingerprinting and background checks for lower socio-economic status parent volunteers at chosen school or schools. Suggest a trial of 15 payments of \$100 each for qualifying volunteers with report back to City Council on the program after a one-year trial. In tandem, investigate whether schools requesting these LIVESCAN paid programs may be funded at individual schools via a CDBG grant. Determine the best way to accomplish this on a yearly basis.

Estimated Project Cost: \$1500

If cost are involved, is it included in the adopted City budget? No.

Project Timeline (Anticipated Start and End Dates): Agree on 12-month program with Marblehead school. Start date ASAP.

Resources Needed (including Staff hours): Unknown at this time. Should be minimal. Staff to administer this program upon direction from Council.

Project Name: Updating Resource Registry - Develop Quick Resource Microsites with Information on Resources.

Purpose: To help residents and staff better leverage available resources, and to reduce inefficiency and discontentment caused by people approaching the incorrect resources by developing an easy-to-use, attractive resource guide for San Clemente residents and families.

Goals: This resource will serve as a valuable tool for City staff and residents and will be foundational to other beneficial projects.

Deliverable: Updated resource registry. Imbedded in current city website as a micro-site. QR code stickers on city signs so people seeking services can scan the QR code and go the the city resource directory.

Deliverable: Develop mobile friendly microsites with information on resources, contacts and "if-that-then-this" style guides, which will be designed to be easily shared on social media and mobile platforms.

Deliverables: At council's option, either a digital proof for final council approval, or if approved, a resource guide would be prepared in both print and digital forms.

Estimated Project Cost. \$2,500 if only a digital version is required. Additional printing costs will be needed if printed guides are desired.

The Committee expects to be able to develop the mobile-friendly micro-sites at no costs. City IT staff will need to create and upload the micro-sites to the City website.

Project Timeline (Anticipated Start and End Dates): November 2024– May 2025

Resources Needed (including Staff hours): Estimated 40 hours IT staff support needed to create micro-site, imbed the resources on the city website.

Project Name: Junior Leadership Program & Career Panel for High School Students

Purpose: Mirror the adult city Leadership Program already in existence. Target 10-15 high school students to participate. Support Career Panel Event at SCHS.

Goals: To provide an avenue for students to learn about a field or fields of work within the city that they may want to pursue in their education and career. Departments to include Planning Division, Code Compliance, Public Works, Utilities, Finance, Park Rangers, and PR/Social Media.

Deliverables: Engage in discussions with the City Manager and the other people within city leadership that administer this program to determine how best to tailor the program to make it suitable for high school students. Suggest SCHS as our partner school for the project. Additionally, to solicit businesses to participate in an annual career panel even at San Clemente High School. Investigate paid or unpaid internship programs. Seek opportunities for City staff members to attend outside events as they surface.

Estimated Project Cost: No cost. If costs are involved, is it included in the adopted City budget? N/A

Project Timeline (Anticipated Start and End Dates): One year

Resources Needed (including Staff hours): Minimal

Project Name: SCHS Humanitarian Award and Support

Purpose: Working with SCHS administration, identify up to three SCHS Juniors who have performed significant community service projects.

Goals: Recognition of outstanding efforts by SCHS students engaged in significant community service projects.

Deliverables: Selected students will be presented a certificate at an appropriate city council meeting, and the HAC will select, from among its members, an appropriate member for mentorship during a selected student's senior year. That mentor will also provide a letter of recommendation for college admission purposes.

Estimated Project Cost. \$50 to hand out flyers in every junior classroom. \$500 for award plaques
