Regular Meeting Minutes

August 5, 2024

These minutes reflect the order in which items appeared on the meeting agenda and do not necessarily reflect the order in which items were actually considered.

A Regular Meeting of the Coastal Animal Services Authority was called to order by Chair Federico on August 5, 2024 at 8:01 a.m.. at San Clemente City Hall, located at 910 Calle Negocio, San Clemente, in Community Conference Room.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

1. CALL TO ORDER

The CASA Meeting was called to order at 8:01 a.m. with all members present.

2. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

4. <u>ITEMS FROM THE STAFF</u>

Shelter Updates

ACO's and PPF presented at San Clemente Christian School for their Summer School students.

Vaccination Clinic was hosted at the Dana Point Community Center on June 30, 2024. We had 48 dogs through during the two hours of operation. A community member also sponsored microchips to anyone that wanted one.

Eagle Scout is finishing up the installation of fire hydrants and new drinking fountains in the dog play yards.

Jamie requested a thank you be sent to South Coast Water District for donating the hydrants.

A second Eagle Scout refaced the Trainer's Hut, doing minor repairs to the siding and repainting the exterior.

PPF and CASA completed a transfer of 3 feral shelter cats to a sanctuary in Kings County. We accepted 5 adoptable cats in return for one of our cats and PPF sponsored the other two cats at \$2,500 each.

Staff recruitments for Kennel Aide, Customer Service and Animal Shelter Supervisor positions are currently posted. The Customer Service and Shelter Supervisor positions are internal recruitments.

Shelter Statistics

Staff presented statistics for the 2024 fiscal year.

Notably adoptions were up 9% compared to the prior year.

License sales increased by 3.5%. Of that, our new licenses sold increased by 16%.

Vickie recommended including a clinic flyer with license renewal notices.

Jamey asked about text renewals.

Jen said that it doesn't seem to be a feature Chameleon will be offering at this time.

PPF has a couple of volunteers that may have insight into this in their professional lives.

Staff is open to any ideas or expertise in the field to help us reach more of our residents.

Surgery Clinic Update

Staff presented information on what expanding the clinic days to three per month would look like for income vs. costs.

Our insurance company does not anticipate any additional insurance costs to us as long as we are in compliance with State and Federal regulations and we have a robust contractual agreement in place with the contract Veterinarian, including what insurance would be required for the contractor to carry.

Staff anticipates that as part of the build-out we will be able to re-use existing cabinetry during construction.

A net income running the clinic three days per week could potentially be \$34,000.

Other local clinics in Chino and Long Beach have seen their public services expand from only spay/neuter to full-service vet care facilities since Covid as the community's need for affordable services expanded.

Jamey asked what the impact to our sheltering services is?

Jen said it will free up ACO's as they will not have to make daily vet runs. We would like to conduct surgery days on Mondays since we are closed, so it will not impact other daily functions, such as adoptions and licensing.

Jeff added that Mission Viejo Shelter is also looking into a similar model.

Jamey added that he anticipates approximately \$60,000 in construction plus \$40,000 estimated in equipment/supplies.

Jamey asked Mark if we want to move forward with a detailed plan.

Mark agreed that this is a need for the community.

Jen added that we see our next steps as identifying a construction timeline, have in place a co-operating and funding agreement between CASA/PPF, research and secure veterinary help, and marketing.

Jamey asked if we would have a different fee structure for residents vs. non-residents?

Stephanie said it isn't in this particular model, but we have considered that, as well as more assistance for lower income/military program much like the one we already have in place.

Jamey will provide a detailed construction estimate and timeline. The operating and funding agreement will be challenging. The current funding agreement and the surgery clinic agreement are separate, but one informs the other.

Jeff asked why we have identified only two or three days per month?

The only limiting factor is the availability and expense of the vet and if we can fill the surgery appointments.

Jamey said that three days looks better than two, what does four days look like?

Jen said we could potentially operate it four Mondays per month, but if it expands beyond that we are potentially impacting our other daily operations. That is what happened in Chino, it expanded from a spay/neuter clinic to a full-service vet operating at four days per week and all of a sudden they are running a vet business.

Volunteers will be assisting staff with clerical, customer-facing operations during the surgery day.

Jamey said we don't anticipate starting at four days per month, but it is important to talk through these scenarios and consider possible future impacts.



Shelter and Animal Control Update

Vaccine Clinic – Our next vaccine clinic is scheduled for Wednesday, October 9th from 5-7pm at the Animal Shelter.

Emergency Preparedness Meeting/Evacuation Drill – Staff has been working diligently on updating our Evacuation Plan and have scheduled a meeting/drill with all staff and the volunteers that have signed up to assist with Shelter evacuation. We had almost 50 volunteers sign up! The meeting will be Thursday, October 10th 4-5pm, where staff will review the plan, walk through different scenarios, and answer any questions.

Agency Assist, Mission Viejo/Airport Fire – During the recent Airport Fire certain neighborhoods in the Rancho Santa Margarita area were impacted by mandatory evacuations. Mission Viejo Animal Shelter experienced an influx of animals from these residents that required board and care at their facility. As a result they reached out to us to reduce their inventory of Shelter animals at their facility. We impounded 7 dogs on 9/10/24. Since we had to delay a planned ARM run during this same week, we identified 4 of these dogs that we were interested in keeping. We received permission from Mission Viejo to keep them here and adopt them out, so that group became our ARM run for September. The other 3 dogs were picked up by Mission Viejo staff on 9/16/24.

Recruitments – Recruitments for our Shelter Supervisor, Customer Service, and Kennel Aide positions were completed.

One of our long-time Kennel Attendants was promoted into the Supervisor position.

Our current interim Customer Service Representative was hired into the full-time role.

We have brought on three new Kennel Aides, which recently started and are receiving their training. These Kennel Aides were hired in an on-call capacity and will be filling any open animal care shifts on the schedule.

School Presentation/Visit – The Animal Control Supervisor and Nancy from PPF will be attending an assembly at St. Margaret's Episcopal School on Monday, October 7th and presenting to approximately 500 students.

Students from St. Margaret's have been doing quarterly visits to the Shelter for the past year, and are completing volunteer hours by helping with cleaning/maintenance projects.

Surgery Clinic – Work continues on aspects of the clinic proposal, including establishing an operations plan, identifying staffing needs, and how the clinic will impact or inform the new funding agreement between CASA and PPF. Staff has updated the proposal with a look at 3 days vs. 4 days of operation per month and what the potential costs and revenue would be.

Subject: CASA PENSION PLAN ADMINISTRATION

Recommended

Action(s): STAFF RECOMMENDS THAT the Board:

1. Receive and File the Report

Background: In 2014/2015, the Coastal Animal Services Authority applied to have CalPERS as

the pension administrator for the JPA's pension plan. Initially, the application was denied. In 2020, after changes were made to the funding agreement, state law, and funding of the existing pension plan further direction to proceed was received by staff. A new request was submitted to complete the financial review, which was the first step in the application process. CalPERS staff completed the financial review of CASA and upon approval the application was submitted, actuarial reports were requested and received, and various resolutions and forms were submitted

to approve the transfer.

Discussion: On July 8, 2024, CASA successfully transitioned active employees over to

CalPERS. A total of 5 participants transferred with 3 Classic members and 2 PEPRA employees. In connection with that transfer of past service credit a financial transfer of \$1.3 million was moved from CSCERP assets to CalPERS representing employee contributions (and interest) of \$365,000 and employer contributions of \$937,000. This funding is near 100% of the past liability, however

valuations are subject to risk pool and actual versus expected impacts.

As for the CSCERP plan currently, approximately 16 retired or inactive CASA employees are in the CSCERP plan. Annual contributions to address the Unfunded Accrued Liability will continue to be made annually to address prior service. Additionally, a new actuarial valuation for CSCERP will be done to determine the unfunded liability due to the transition of the active employees to CalPERS.

Participant contributions are currently being made to the CalPERS plan at the following rates:

With the approval of the new budget, full-time and benefited part-time staffing levels for CASA are at the following levels. The following is a list of the approved benefitted staffing levels for CASA:

- CASA General Manager 1 FTE
- Animal Services Supervisor 2 FTE
- Animal Services Officer 3 FTE
- Kennel Attendant 2.75 FTE
- Customer Service Specialist 1 FTE

Part time employees are not covered by CalPERS and are covered through a social security alternative plan, as opposed to CalPERS. These employees work less than 1,000 hours annually and are not part of CalPERS and include the following classifications:

- Kennel Aide
- Reserve Animal Services Officer
- Office Assistant

Additional actions completed included modifications to the CalPERS Health contract with CASA to allow for the retiree medical contributions to be made from monthly retiree pension amounts and the filing of the resolution to address pre-tax status of the pension contributions.

Subject: Presentation Of The Salary Survey Findings For Coastal Animal Services

AUTHORITY (CASA) FULL-TIME REPRESENTED CLASSIFICATIONS.

Fiscal Impact: There is no fiscal impact associated with presentation of the salary survey findings.

Summary: CASA is in its third year of the 2022-2025 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with

the CASA Bargaining Unit of the San Clemente Employees Association. In year three, MOU Article I - Wages includes a salary survey of all represented CASA classifications. The survey data was compiled by the San Clemente Human Resources Manager with support provided by the CASA General Manager and is

presented in summary format to the CASA Board for their information.

Discussion:

At direction of the CASA Board, a salary survey project was managed "in-house" by the San Clemente Human Resources Manager with support provided by the CASA General Manager. The salary survey included all five of the represented classifications within the bargaining unit. A number of data sources were utilized including job descriptions, salary schedules, and pay rates for comparable jobs among the survey agencies. Seven agencies were surveyed including Cities of Mission Viejo, Irvine, Laguna Beach, Costa Mesa, Westminster, and Newport Beach along with Orange County Animal Care (OCAC). Other than Mission Viejo and OCAC, animal control and/or sheltering services are primarily provided by police departments within their cities. Salary data was collected in mid-September of this year and is based on salary information with most recent effective dates of July 2024. The hourly part-time classifications and CASA General Manger position were not included in the project.

Following is a summary of findings based on survey agencies median of top salary range for each of the CASA classifications in the bargaining unit:
