8. **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

A. Ole Hanson Beach Club Rehabilitation Concept Plans

Report from the Beaches, Parks and Recreation Director concerning the concept plans for the rehabilitation of the Ole Hanson Beach Club.

Beaches, Parks and Recreation Director Heider and Recreation Manager Passow narrated a PowerPoint presentation entitled "Ole Hanson Beach Club Repair and Rehabilitation" and responded to Council inquiries. A hard copy of the subject presentation, dated January 8, 2013, is on file with the City Clerk.

In response to Council inquiries, <u>Christopher Smith</u> and <u>Stephen Farneth</u>, Architectural Resource Group (ARG), spoke on the possibility of restoring certain windows, creating an entry view of the pool, relocating the 2nd floor restroom, creating openings in the existing pool wall, and extending the pool deck.

Marc Schroeder, San Clemente, displayed slides depicting an historical residence in Del Mar, California, which he helped to restore; recommended that focus be given to repairing structural issues; provided suggestions relative to remodeling of the beach club. Hard copies of Mr. Schroeder's photos are on file with the City Clerk.

<u>Larry Culbertson</u>, President of the San Clemente Historical Society, voiced support for the repair and rehabilitation of the beach club; urged that no modifications be made to the exterior of the building.

<u>Cheryl Moe</u>, San Clemente, summarized and displayed alternative design options; spoke on the possibility of creating an entry view of the pool and better use of long corridors. Hard copies of Ms. Moe's design options are on file with the City Clerk.

<u>Ricardo Nicol</u>, San Clemente, conveyed that the beach club should have a sense of arrival, including an entry view of the pool; suggested that the interior of the building should reflect the beauty of the exterior.

George Gregory, San Clemente, conveyed support for constructing a pool equipment room and installing an elevator on the exterior of the building; stressed the importance for ensuring that the beach club remains functional for use.

<u>Georgette Korsen</u>, San Clemente, spoke on the importance of preserving and restoring historical features of the Ole Hanson Beach Club.

<u>Luis Alvarez</u>, owner of Guicho's Eatery, conveyed that he prefers that the catering kitchen be located near the 2nd floor multi-purpose room. In response to Council inquiry, Mr. Alvarez stated that the existing catering space is adequate for events.

During the course of discussion, individual Councilmember(s) provided the following suggestions for a possible remodel of the Ole Hanson Beach Club. The below statements do not necessarily reflect Council consensus:

- Improve the building entry, including an entry view of the pool.
- Resize and relocate the catering kitchen.
- Relocate the pool equipment, with consideration of a new building or relocation within the interior of the existing building.
- Modify the exterior wall to insert Plexiglas or iron railing walls.
- Install double doors from the club room to the pool deck.
- Improve the appearance of the exterior stairwell gate.
- Install dressing rooms in the women's locker room.
- Create a patio area between the ocean side of the building and slope.
- Additional consideration should be given to phasing of the project.

It was noted that the project should return to Council in conjunction with the CIP process. Council requested that Staff inform Council about costs incurred for the City's Aquatics Center.
