

## Oversize Vehicle Parking

CE-7

San Clemente Municipal Code, Section 17.64.080 Boats, Trailer, and Oversized Vehicle Parking

The City's Code (Section 8.52.030.I) prohibits "trailers, campers, boats and other mobile equipment" to be "stored or parked in front yards and/or setback areas (on) vacant property."

The City Code (Section 17.64.080) allows boats, trailers, and "oversized vehicles" to be excepted from this rule, if they meet the following requirements:

- **Definition of oversized vehicle:** For the purpose of Section 17.64.080, an oversized vehicle is any vehicle, which exceeds any of the following dimensions: twenty (20) feet in length, nine (9) feet in height or seven (7) feet in width. Motor homes and recreational vehicles exceeding these measurements are examples of oversized vehicles.
- **Exceptions** to some of the above requirements are available to individuals who are disabled and require an oversized vehicle to accommodate the individual's daily needs.
- Temporary Parking: Boats, trailers, and oversized vehicles being loaded or unloaded for trips may be temporarily parked on required driveways and within the twenty (20) foot setback area for a maximum of six (6) "round-trips" a year. In this case, a round-trip is one (1) 48-hour period for loading and one (1) 48-hour period for unloading. No two (2) round-trips shall be allowed within a three (3) day period.
- Detailed Specifications: the City's code includes detailed specifications for exceptions for individuals who
  are disabled, parking in required driveways, surfacing of parking areas, and the partial screening
  requirements listed below.
